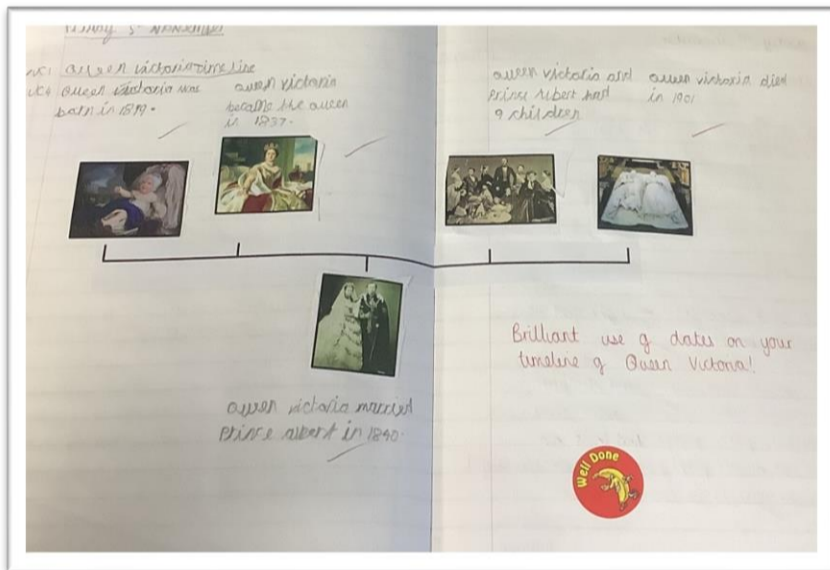
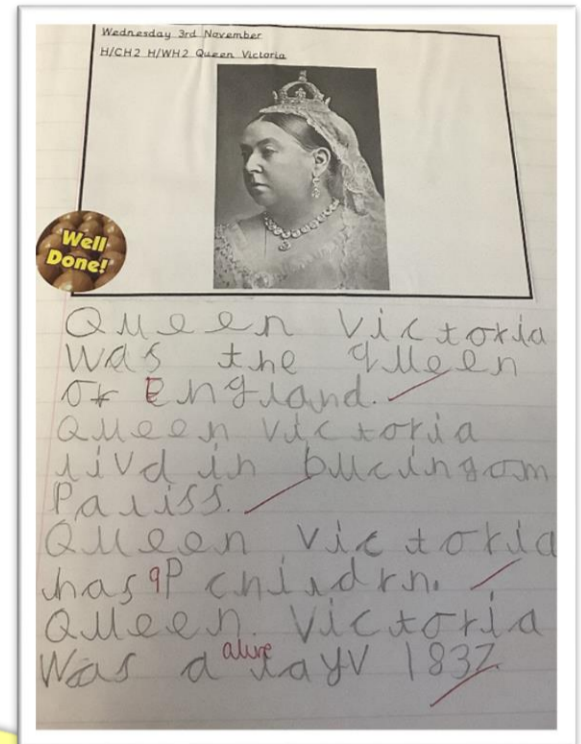
## Project Reflections – Autumn 2: History

Significant Person – Queen Victoria

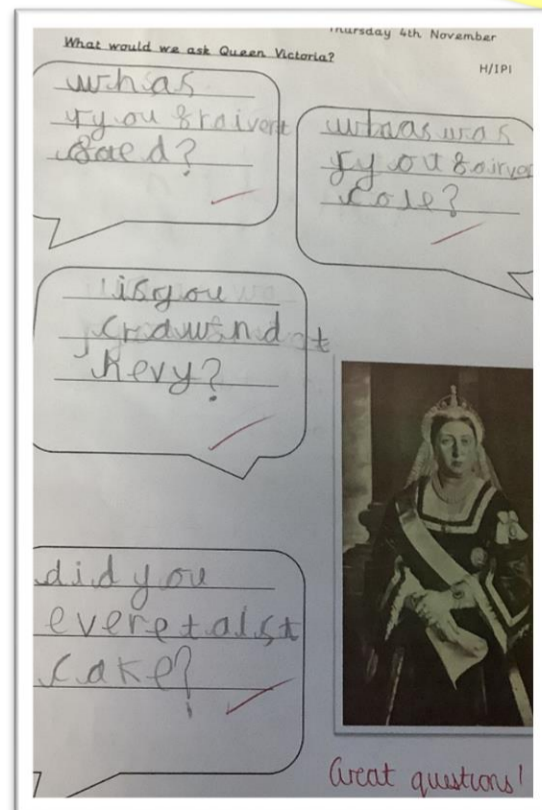
Significant Event – Remembrance Day

We used our digital literacy skills to create a fact page all about Queen Victoria.



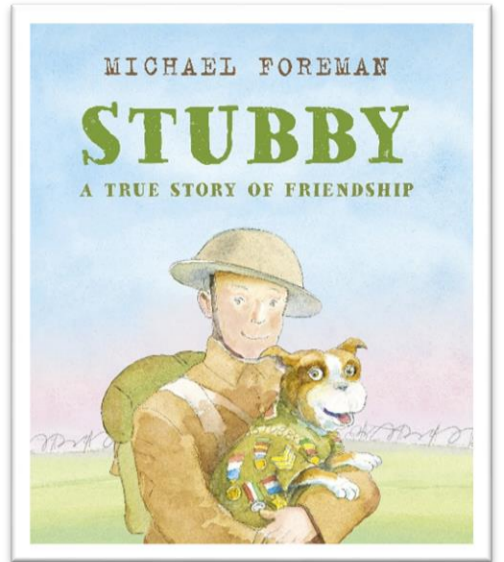
