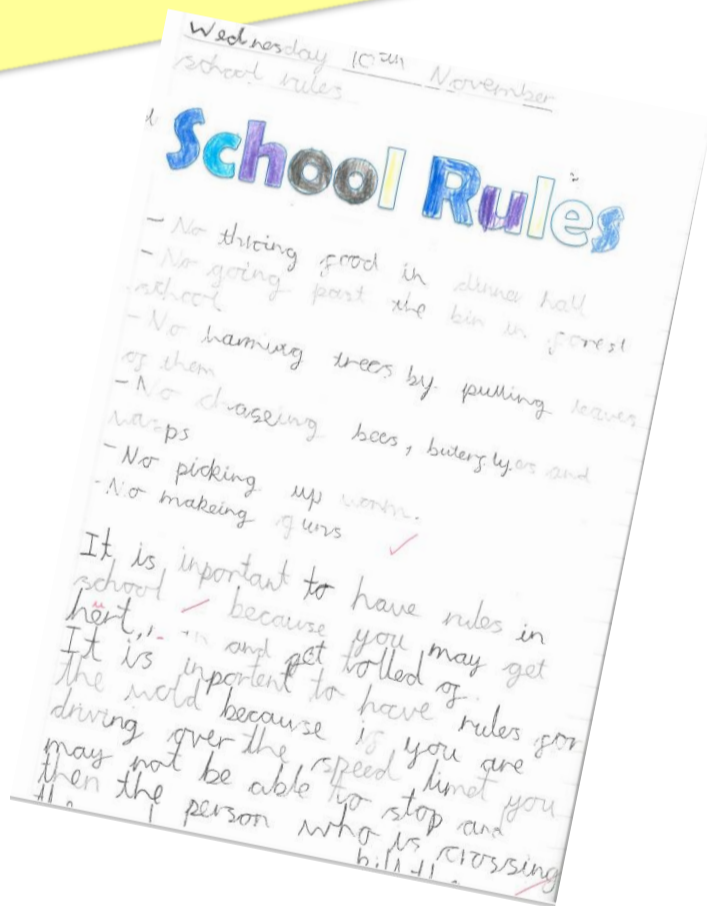
Project Reflections – Autumn 2: RE
