
## Project Reflections – Autumn 1: History


Significant Event/Person – Great Fire of London and Samuel Pepys


We compared fire safety from 1666 to now and realised we have much better fire safety now!

Key Vocabulary


Significant: sufficiently great or important to be worthy of attention; noteworthy.
