

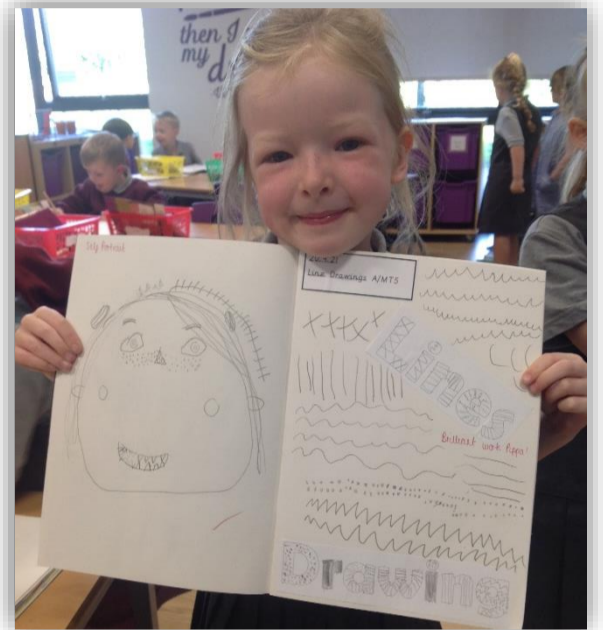
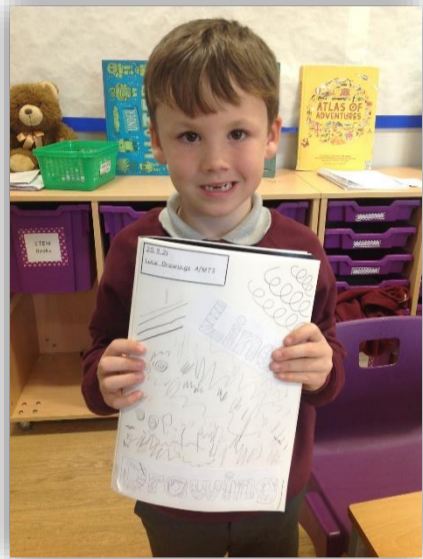

Drawing Skills – Paul Gauguin

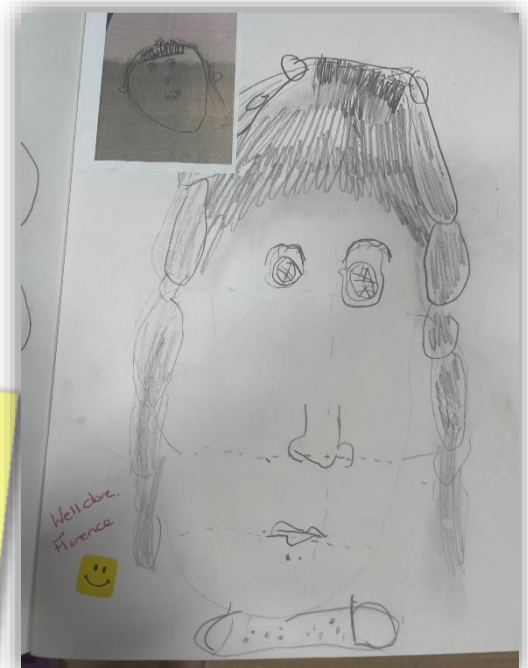
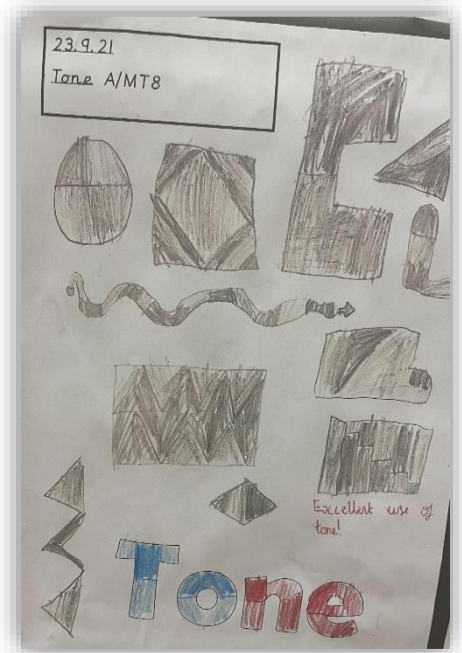
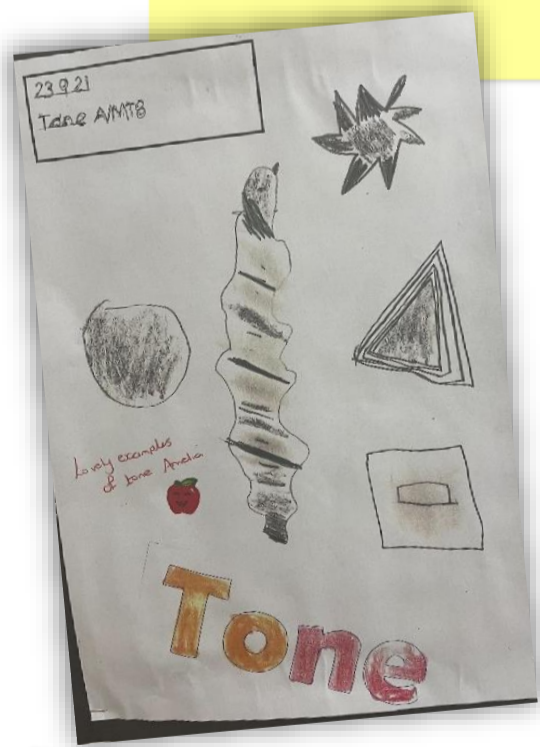
We then began learning different art skills to improve our drawings. We began by exploring drawing different types of lines. The children loved drawing various types of lines including wavy, straight and curvy. We drew them thick and thin and talked about which lines we liked most.

The children started their art project by drawing a 'cold' self-portrait using the mirrors.



The children explored Paul Gauguin's art work, we looked at his pieces of art and explored the different types of lines he used in his work. We then recreated a piece of his famous art work using our line drawing skills and making sure we coloured within the lines.

We then explored 'tone' - the children loved creating their very own 'Tone-y the snake' applying their toning skills.



The children applied the art skills they learnt into a final self-portrait - we made great improvements!
