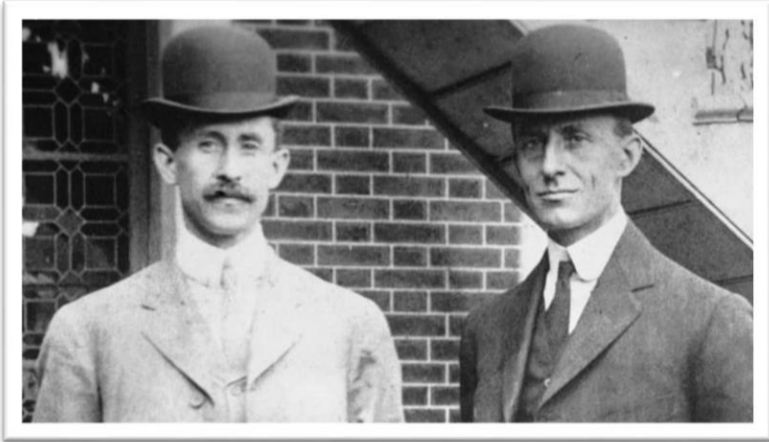

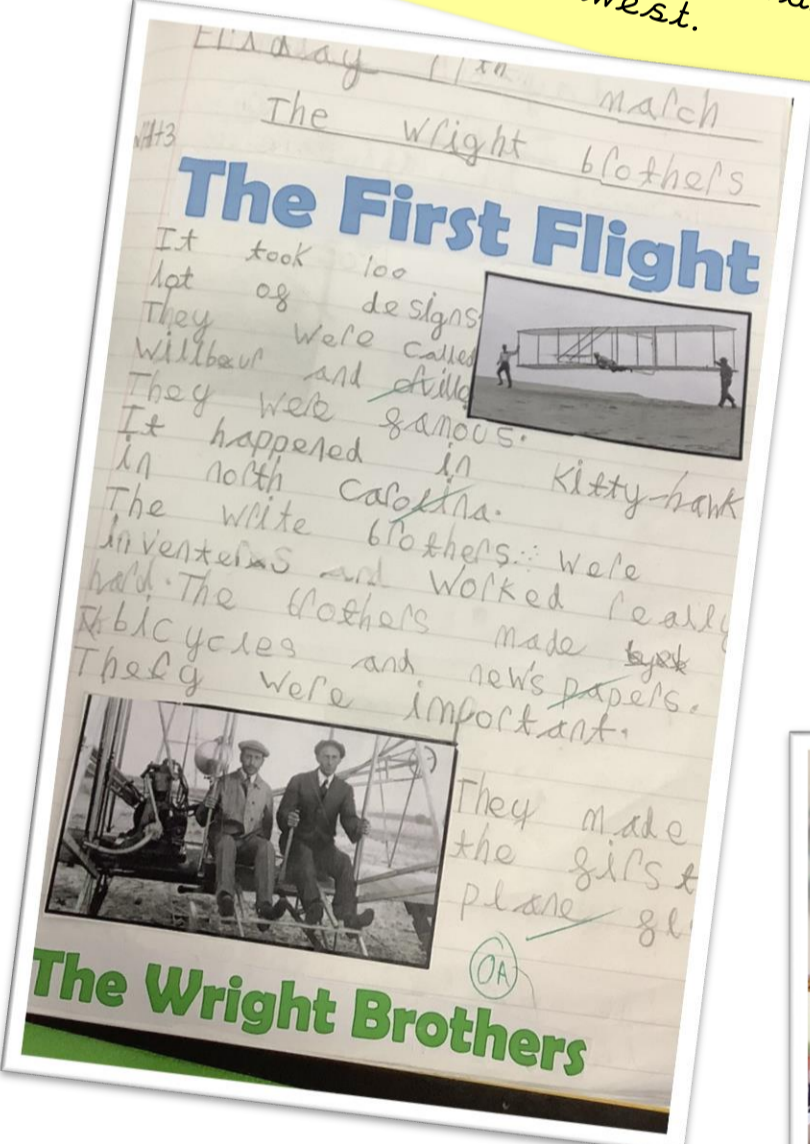
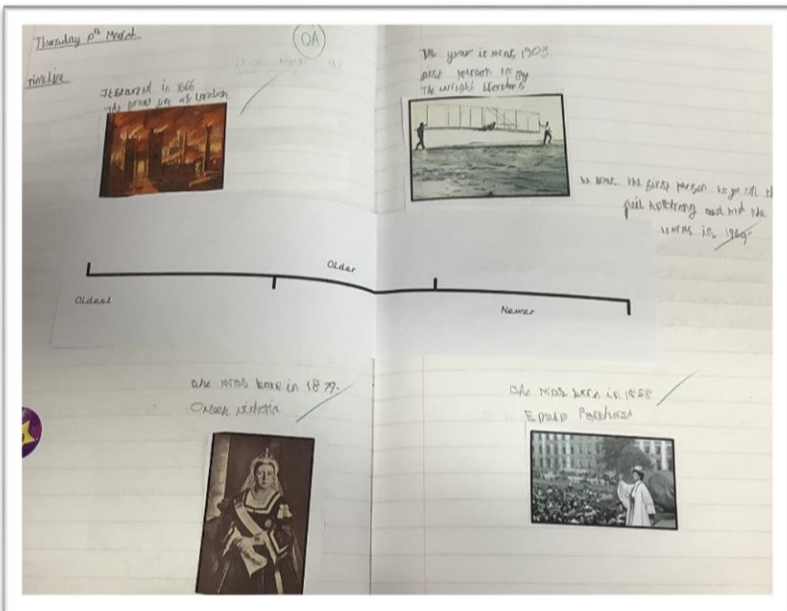
Significant Person – The Wright Brothers

Aviation: the flying or operating of aircraft.



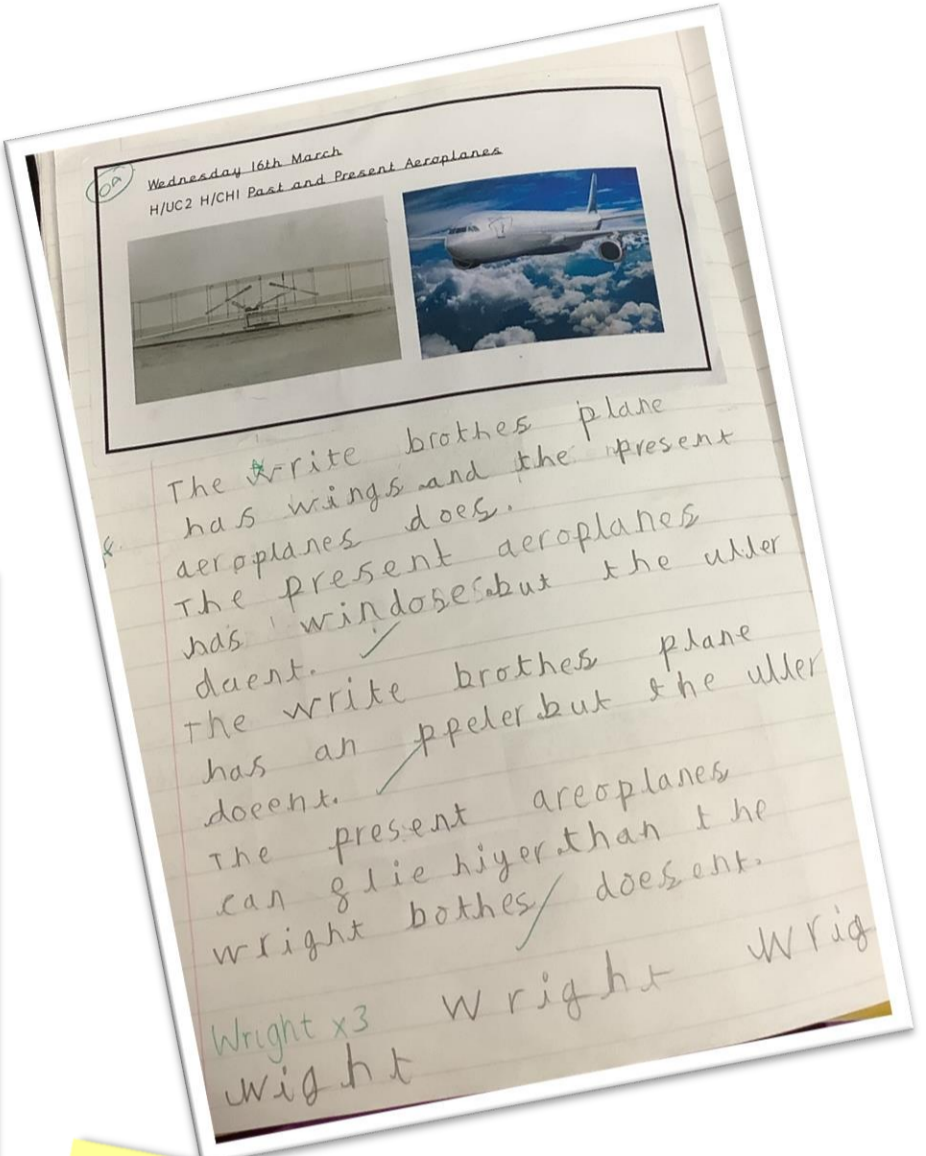
