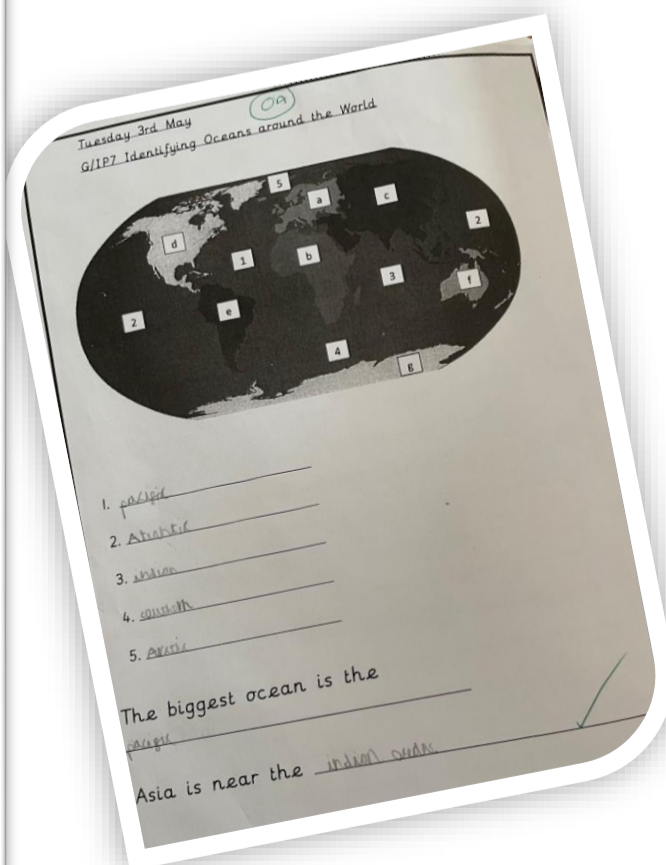
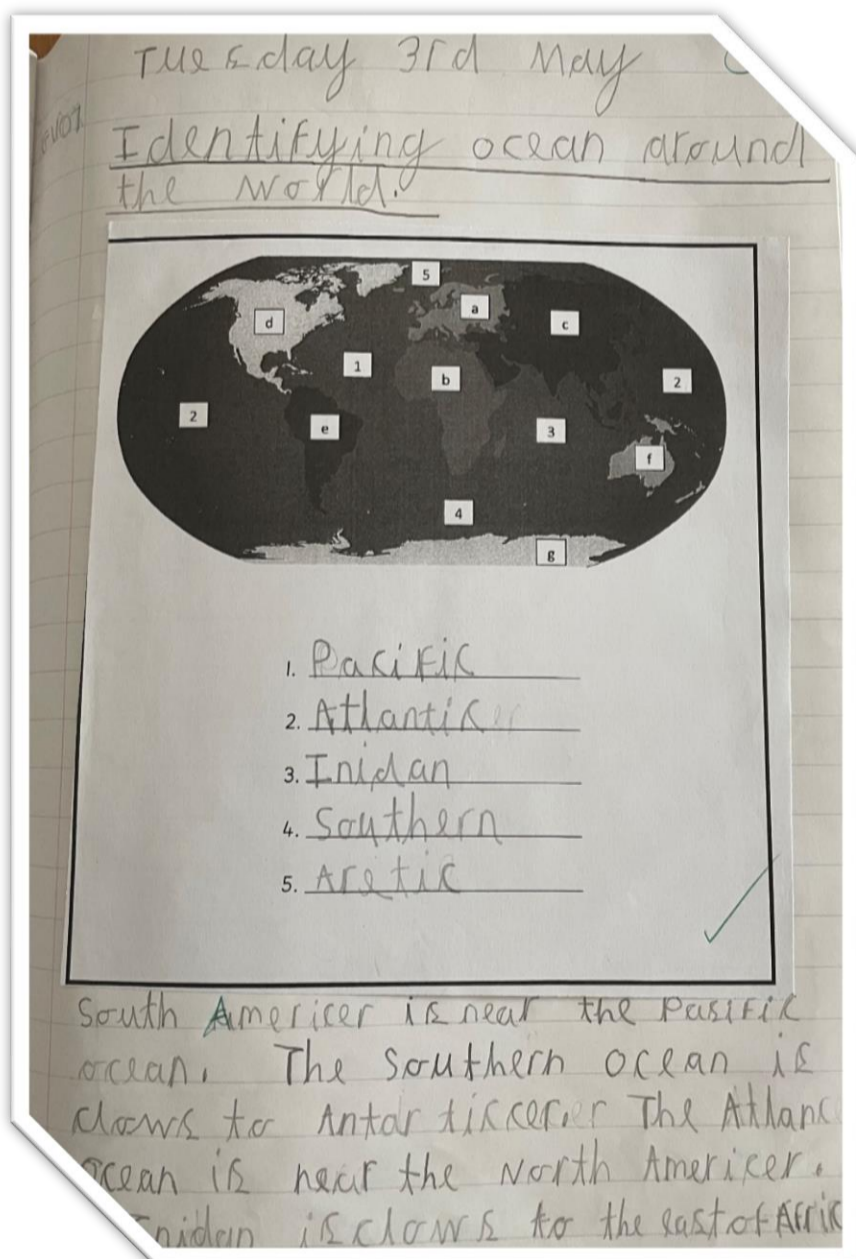
Geography – Understanding the 5 Oceans – Atlantic & Pacific Ocean in Depth

We plotted all the different oceans on the world map.

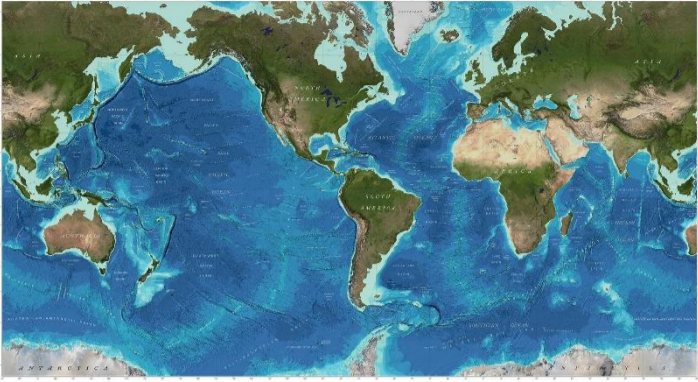

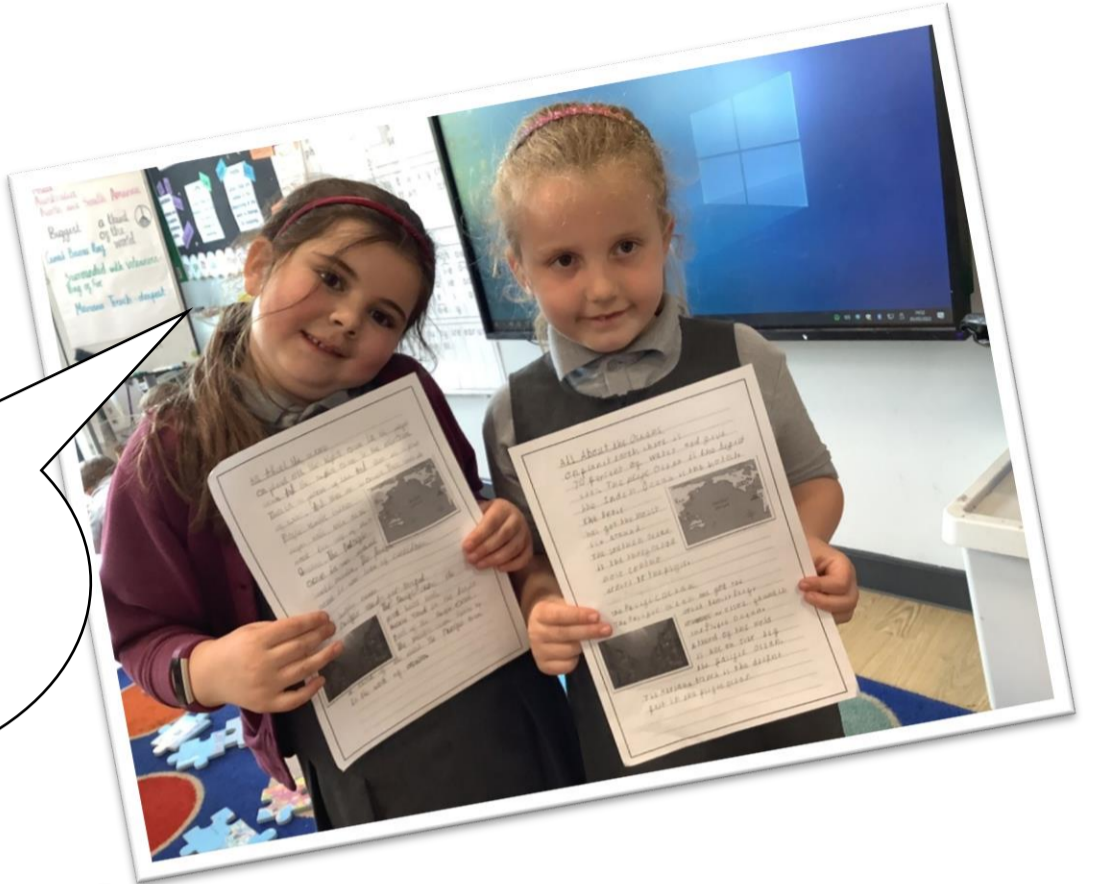
