### Science – Understanding Plants

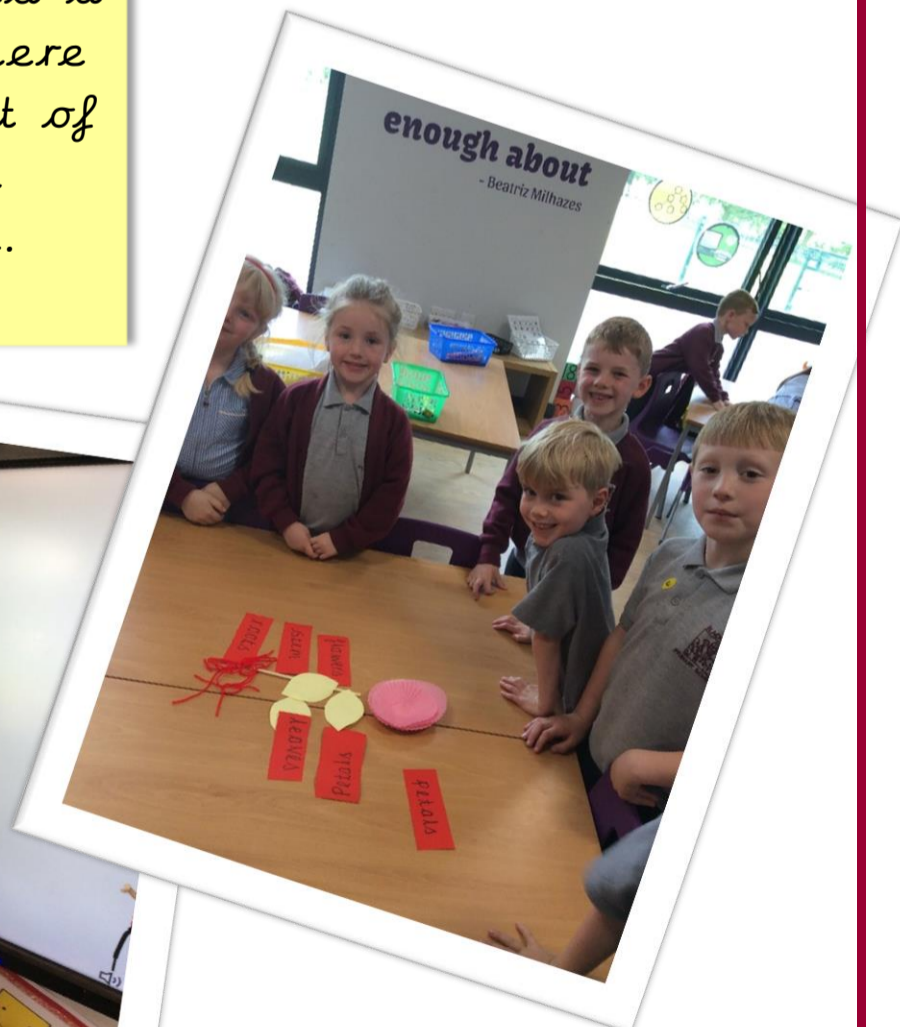

I have found a buttercup - it is a weed.



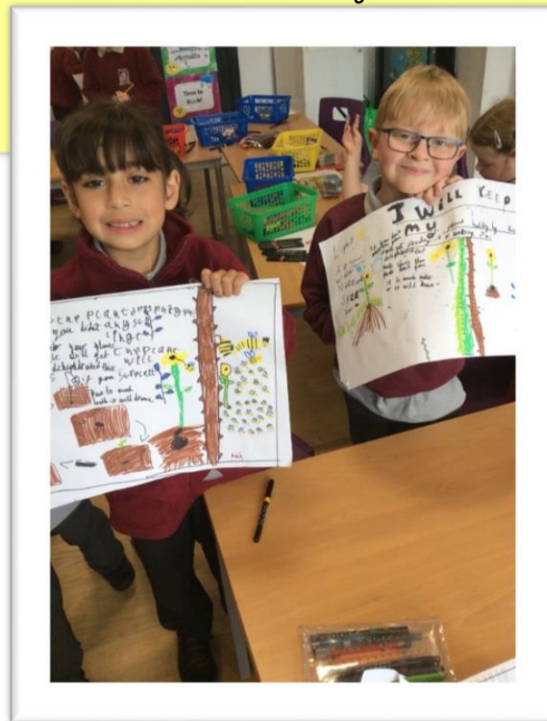
We then worked as a team to label the parts of a plant and played a plant relay game where we created a plant out of art resources and labelled the parts.
