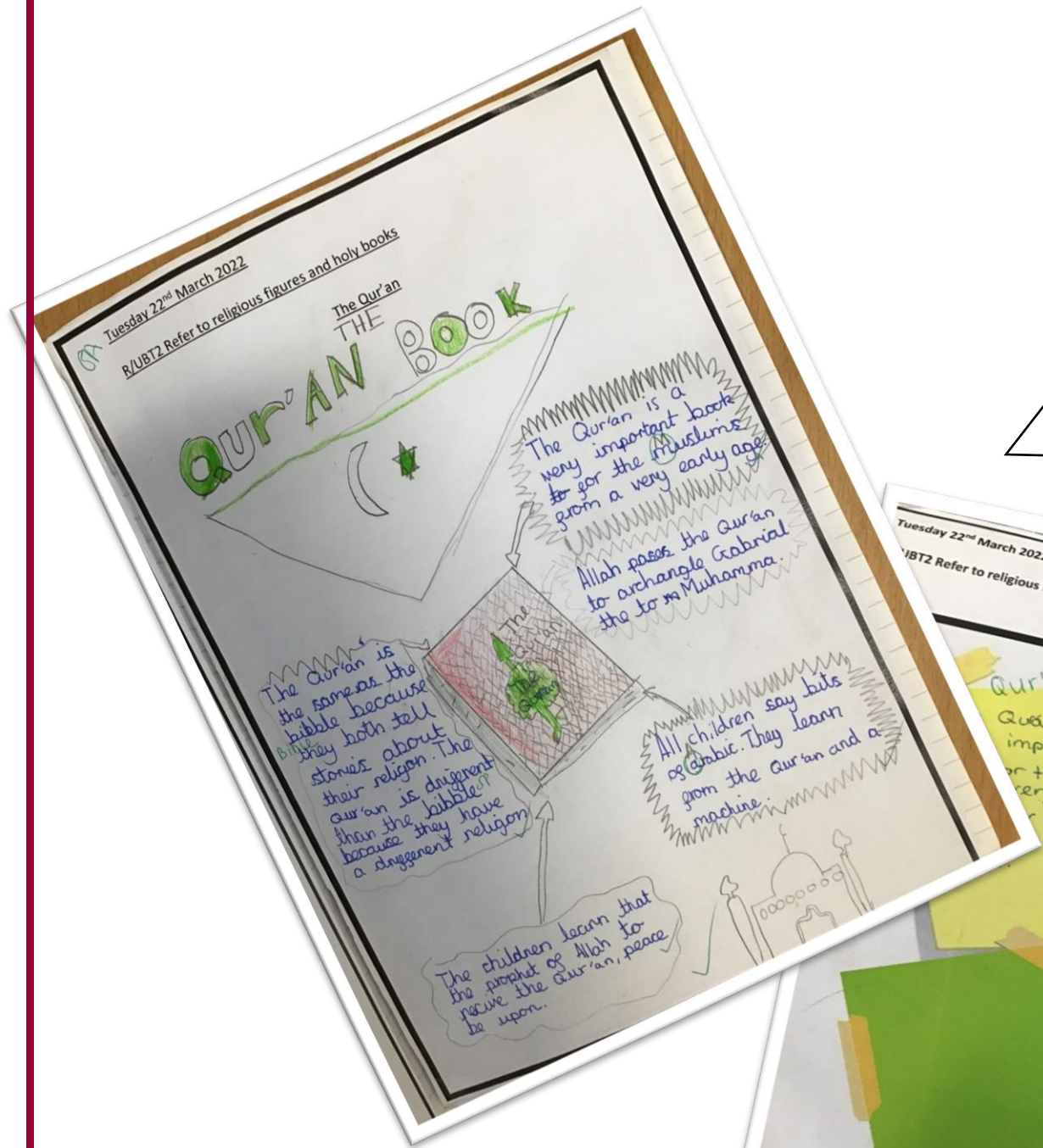

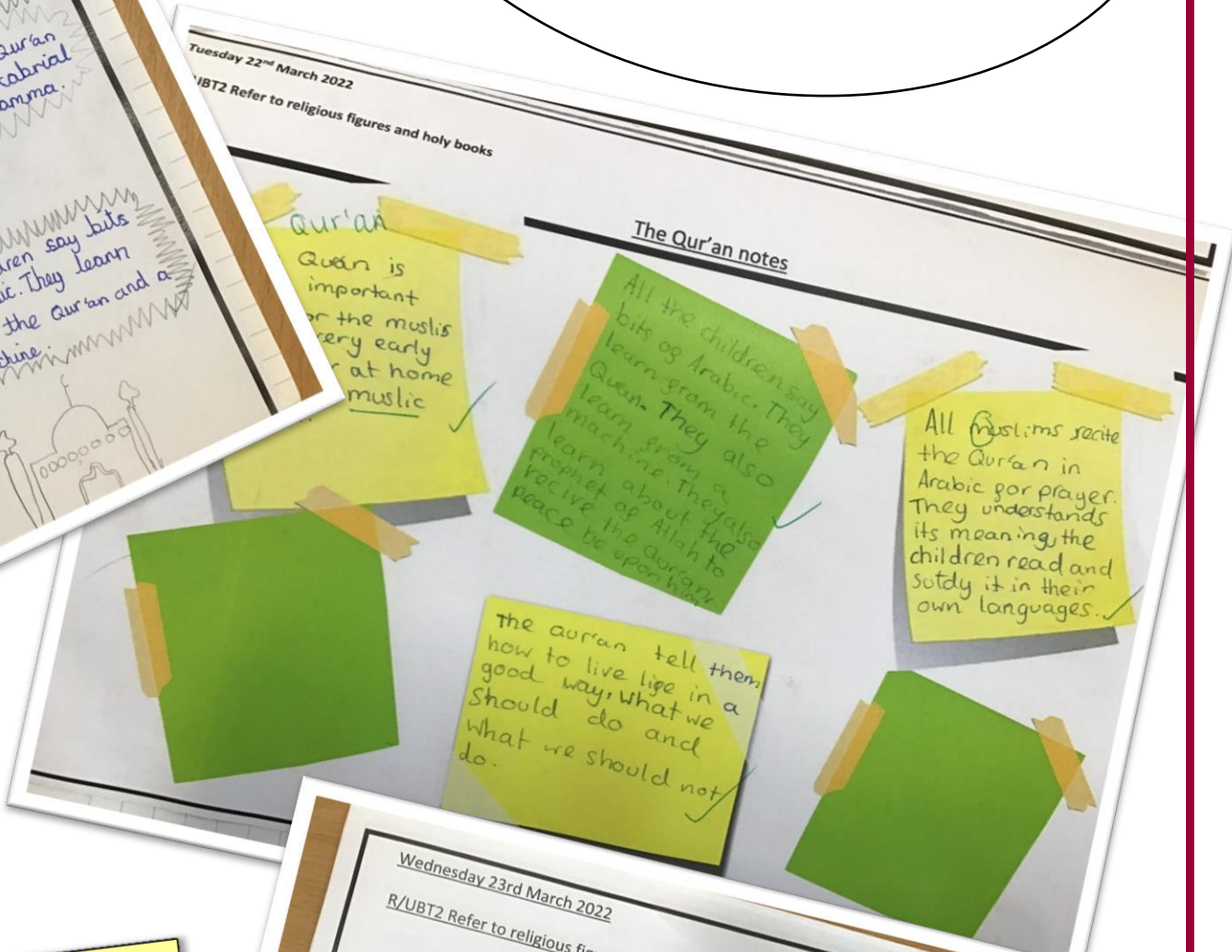
Ramadan - Arabic name for the ninth month in the Islamic calendar. It is considered one of the holiest Islamic months
