The Battle of Bosworth

The Battle of Bosworth was between Henry VII and Richard III in 1485. Reasons Henry won the battle are that some of Richard's army left to join him, giving him more men and making him stronger. Another reason could be that his men performed better or that they were more experienced men. Henry spent his time at the back to protect himself and he was very well protected. His army also stayed close together in groups.



Some reasons that Richard lost the battle might be that Lord Stanley left his side and went to Henry. Or that Richard threatened to kill Lord Thomas Stanley's son. His troops were set out in a poor position for the battle and didn't have loyalty towards him, causing him to lose the battle.

The Tudor Rose

The Tudor Rose was created because Henry VII wanted to create a symbol for the Tudors combining the red and white rose, to mark the significance of the event, now they were all family. This became known as the Tudor Rose, and had red bigger as Henry in that.


Explain how Henry Tudor won the battle of Bosworth. Mention at least one thing that Richard III did wrong, and one thing Henry did right.



Source C tells me Henry liked to eat as he is overweight and that he is lazy because he has to be heaved out of bed. If he had oozing scabs that means he is lazy too.

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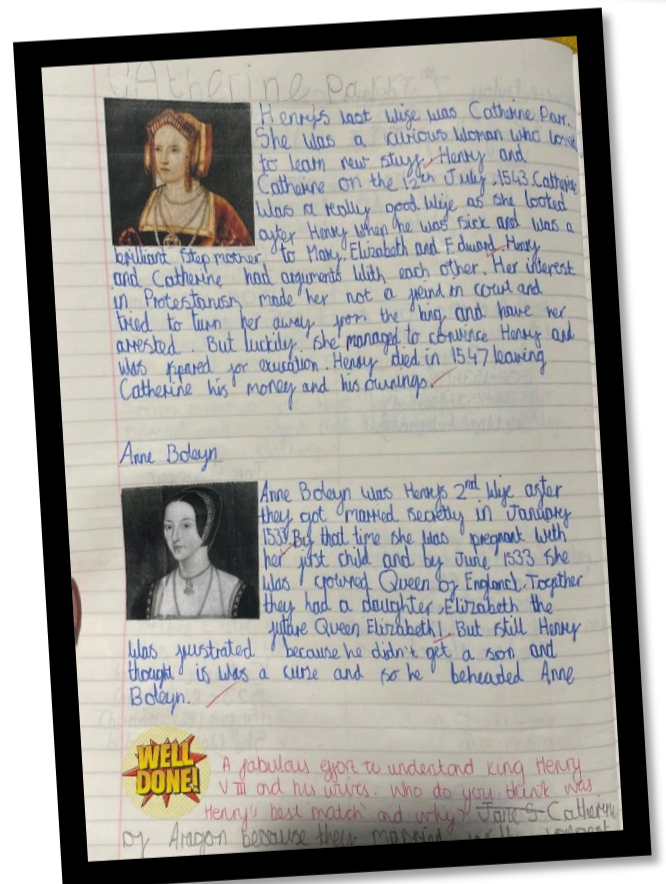
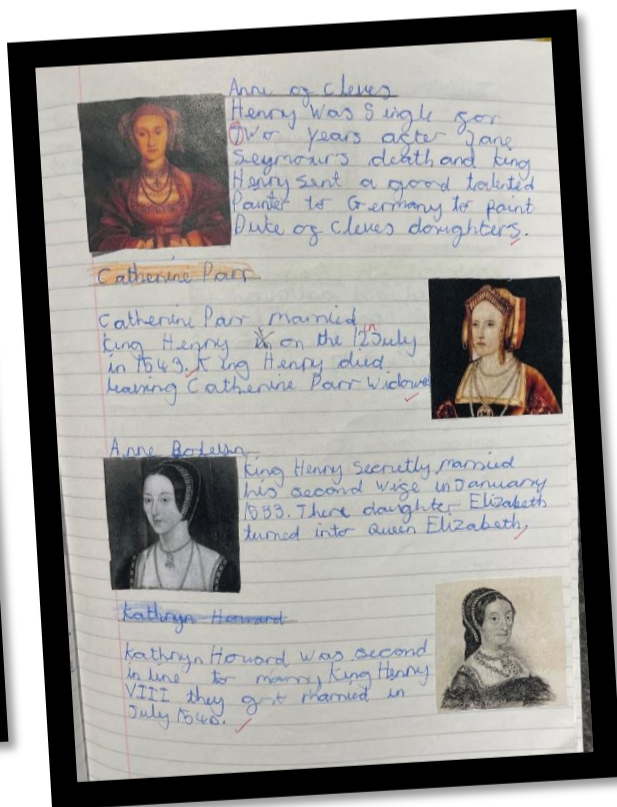
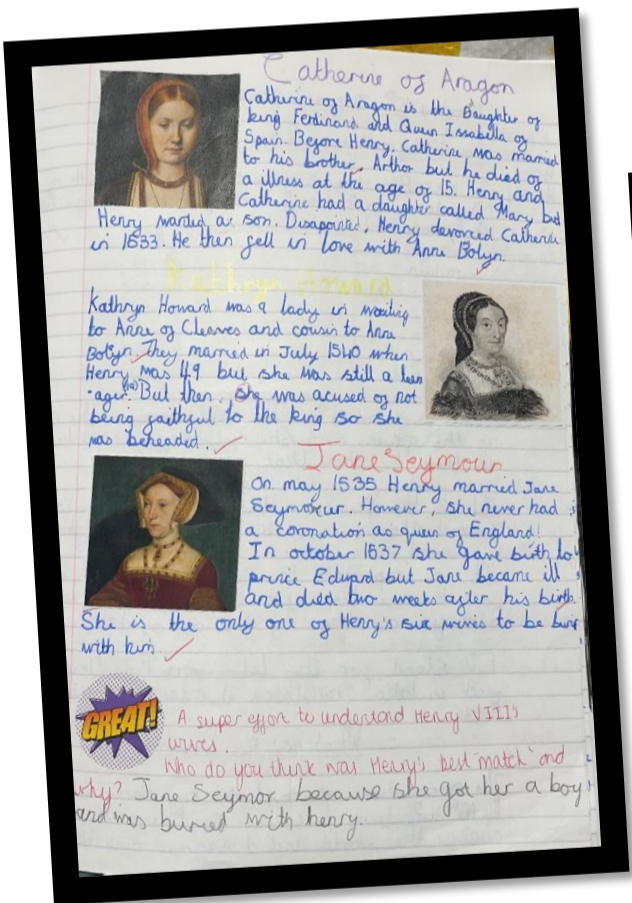
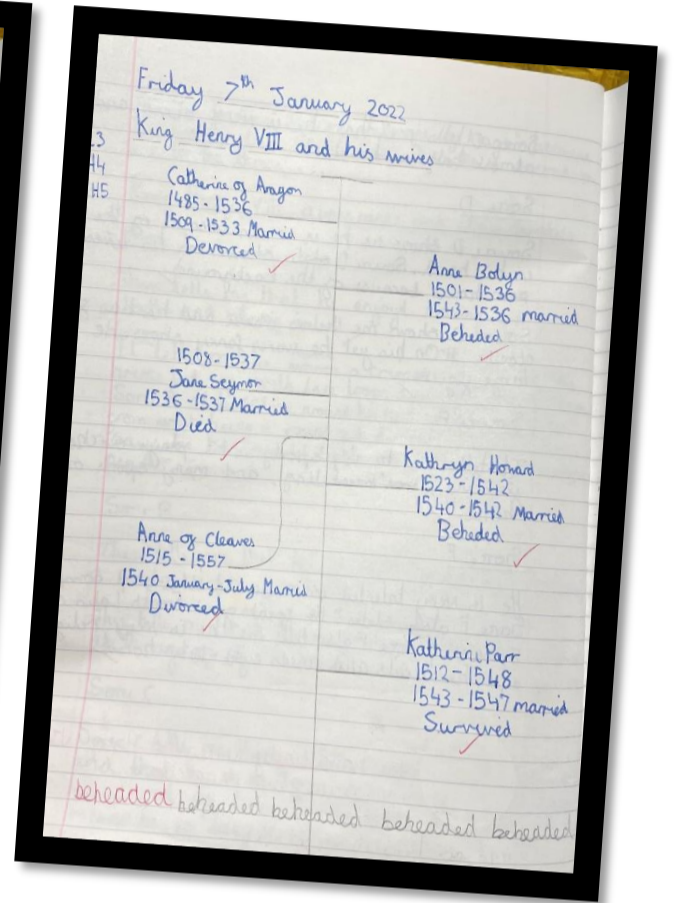
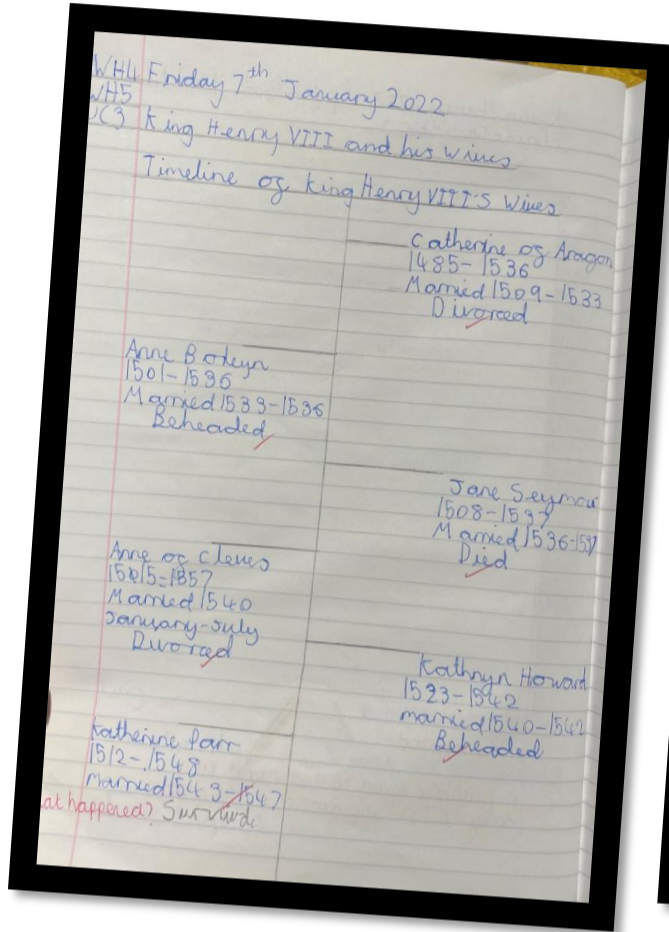

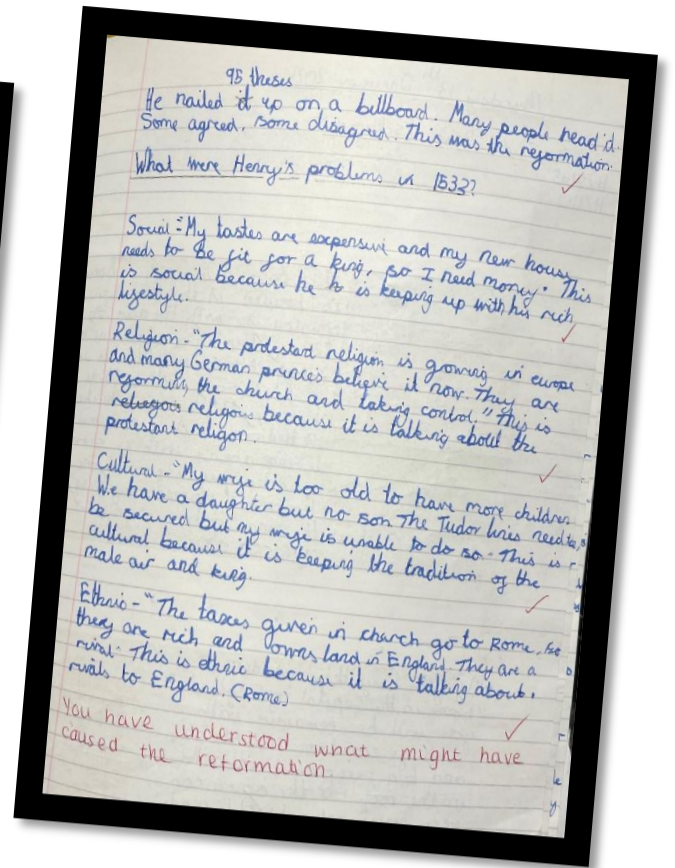
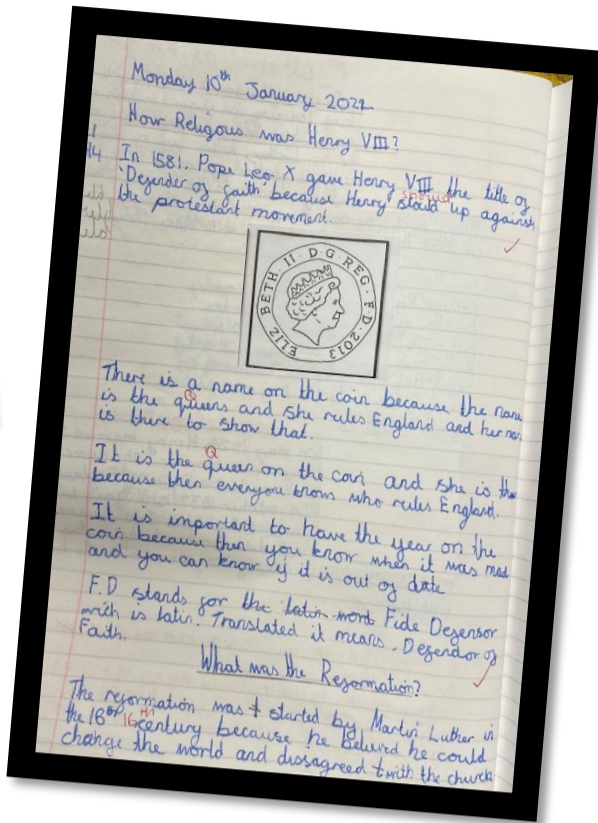
We loved researching Henry and his wives. We know that he divorced 2, beheaded 2, 1 died and 1 survived.



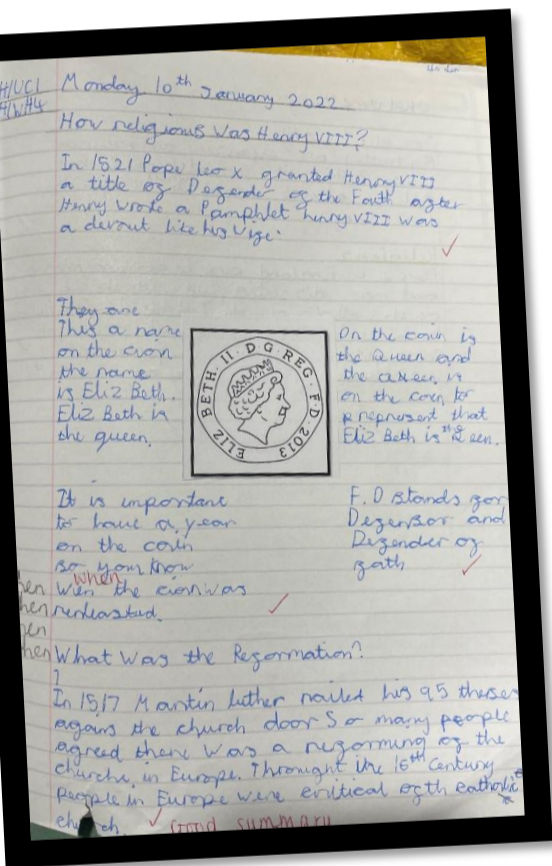
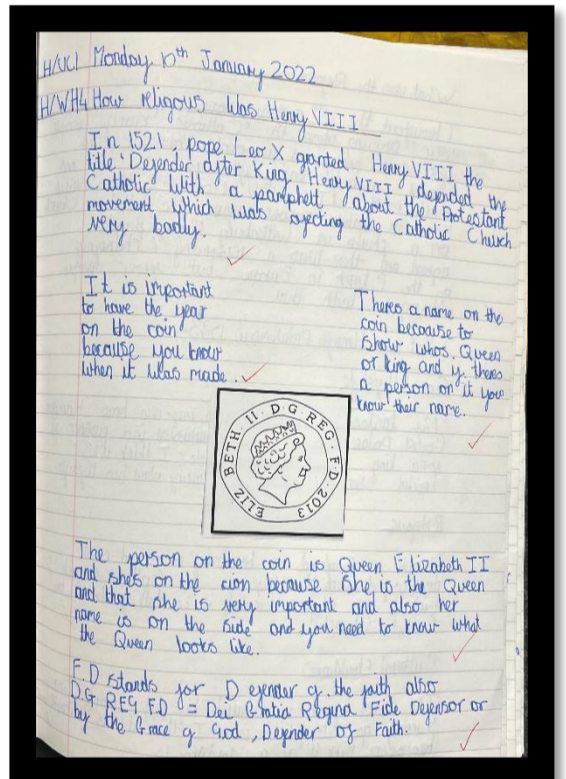
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How religious was Henry VIII?

We looked at how religious Henry was and all the problems which were caused in 1533.

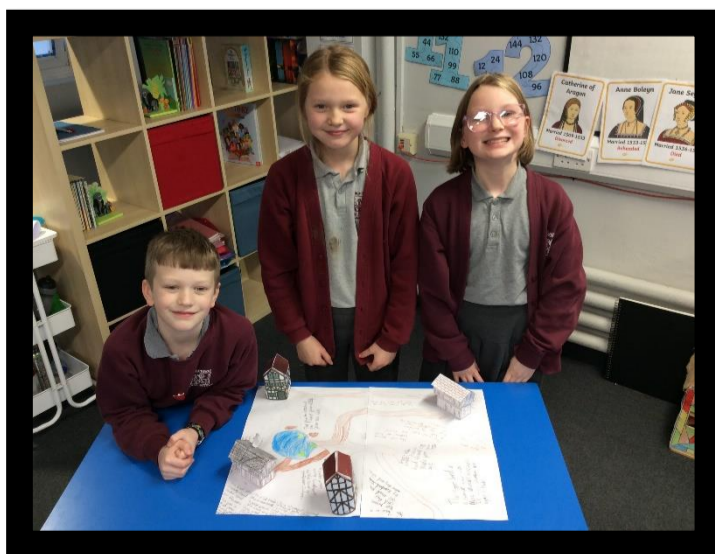


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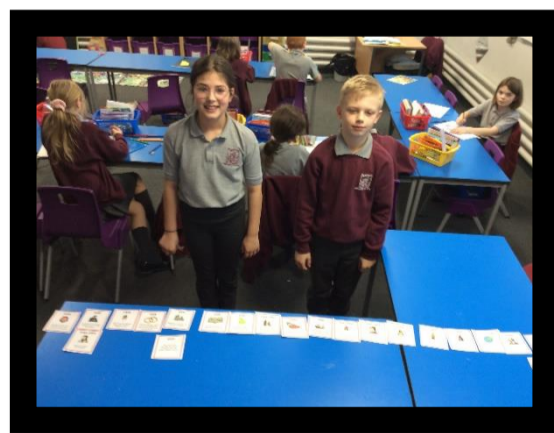
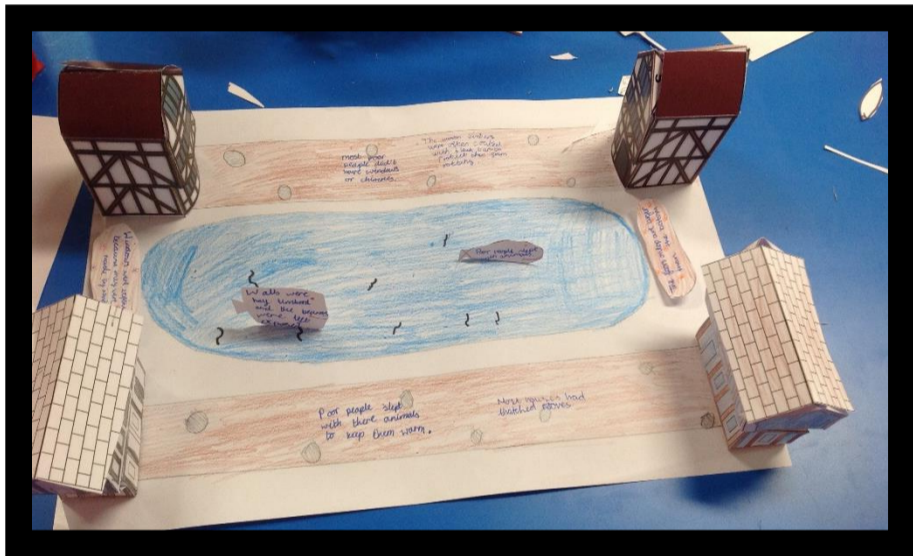
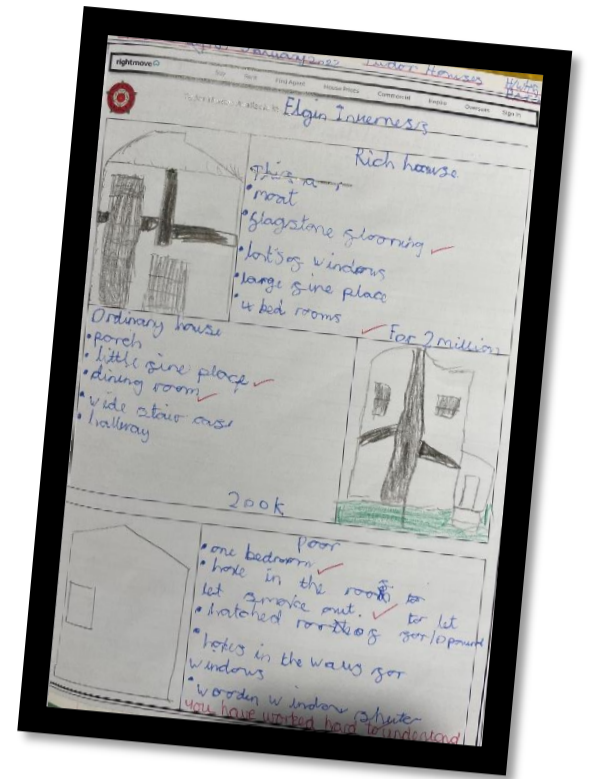
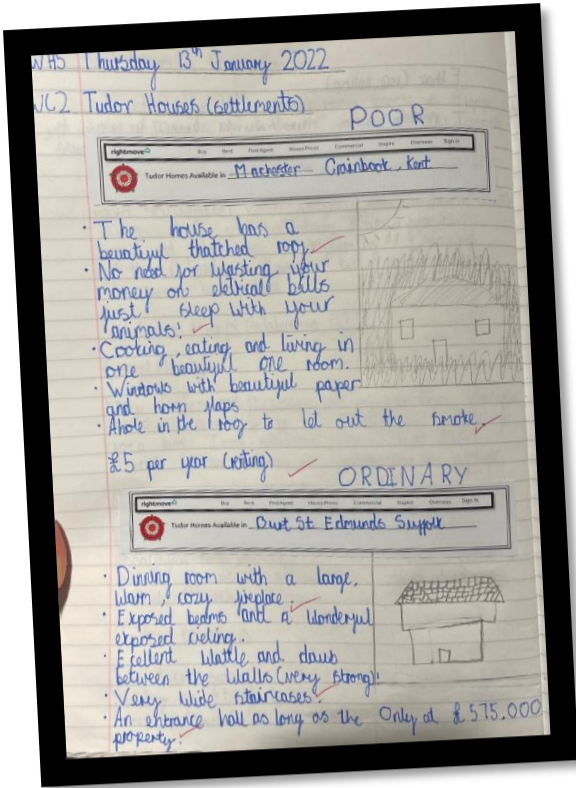


Tudor Houses - Settlements
