

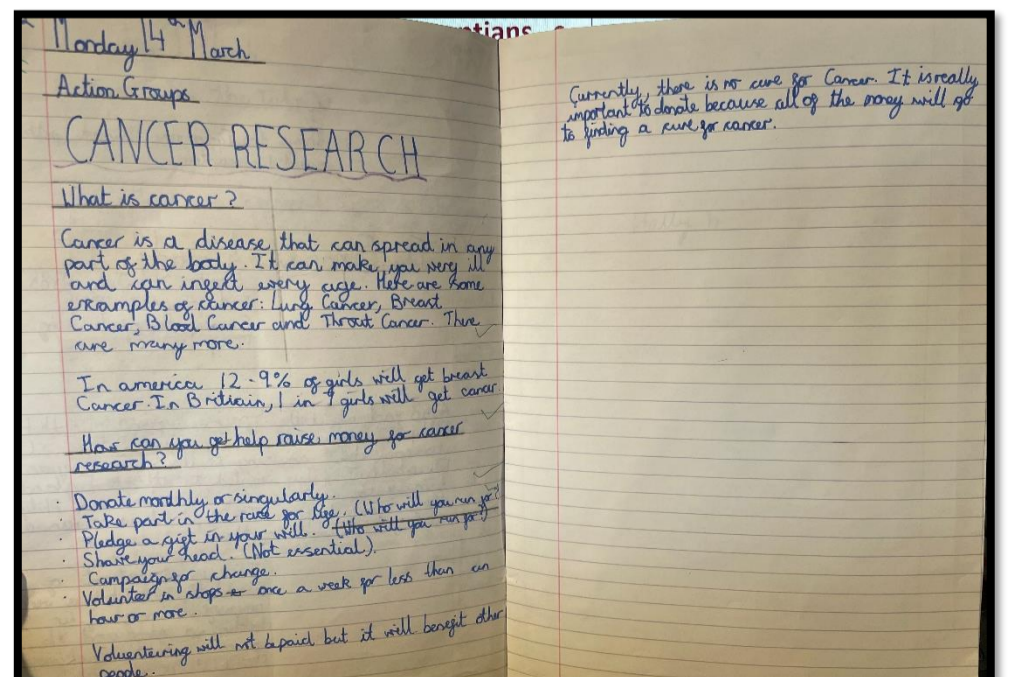
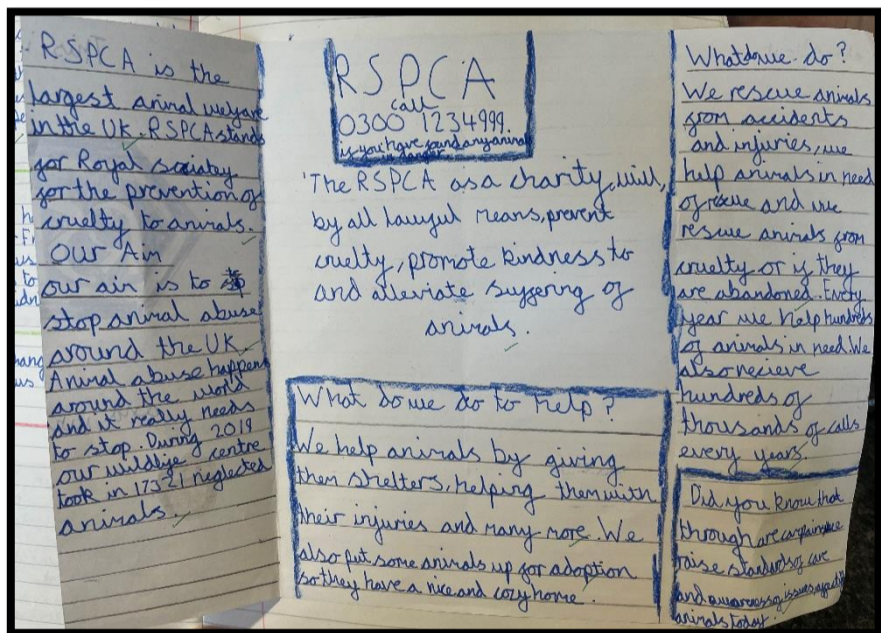
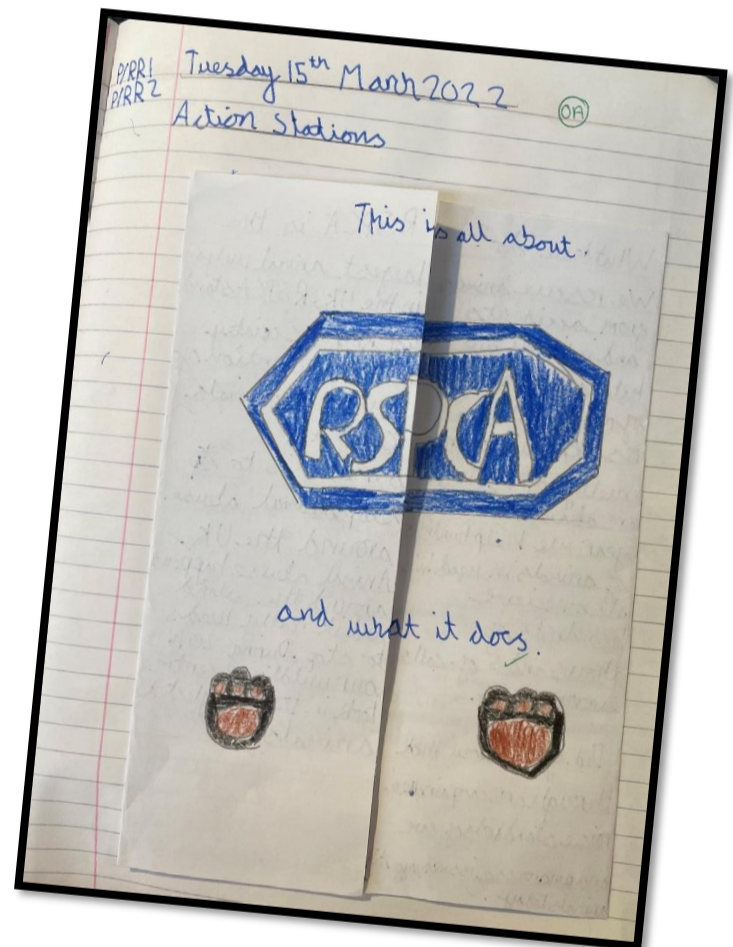

- Any other ideas you have

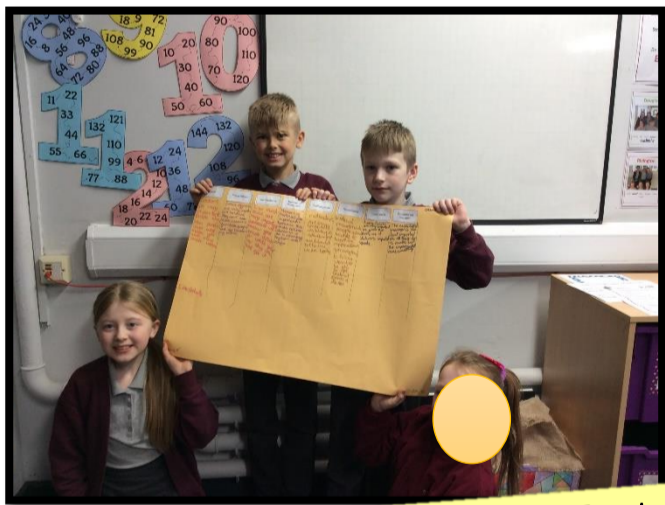
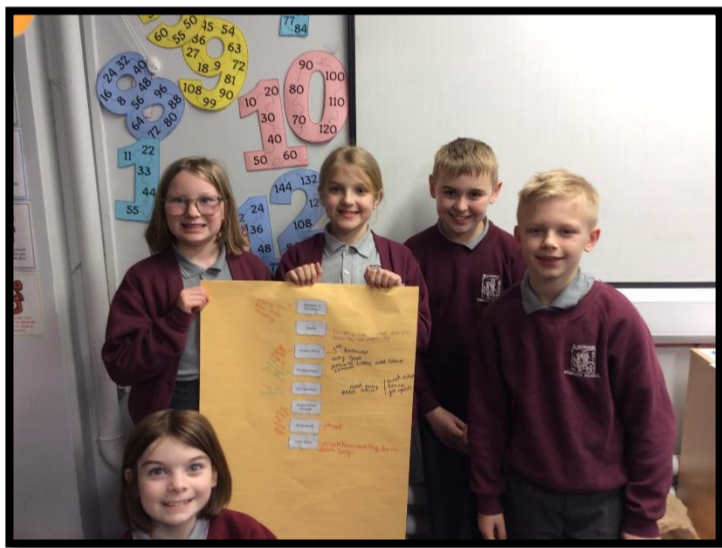
