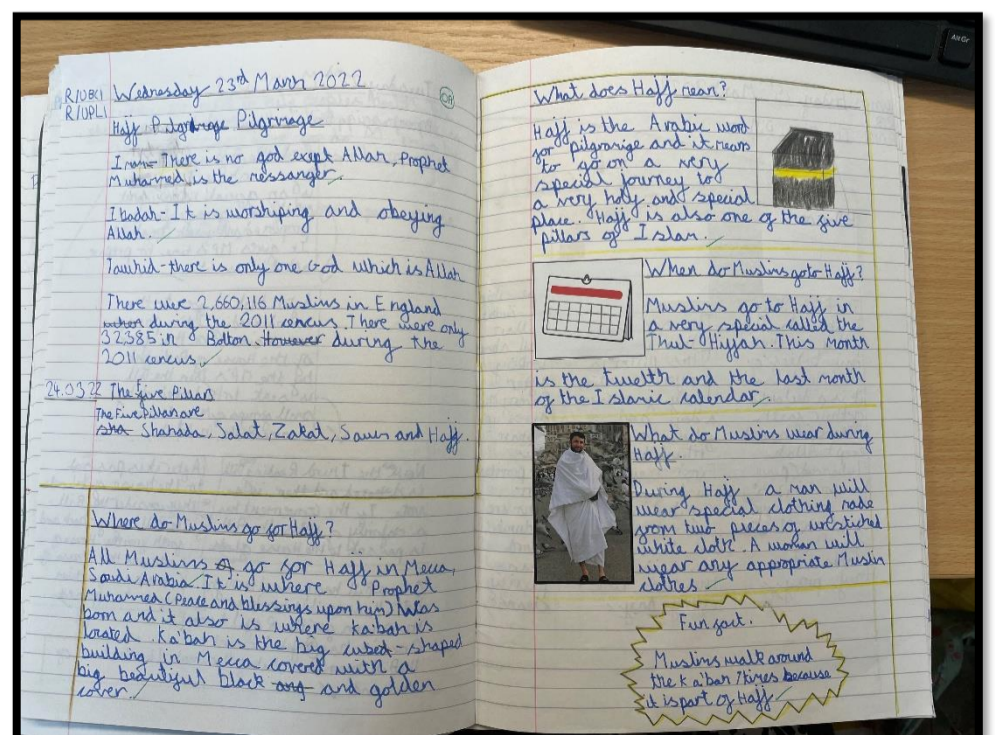
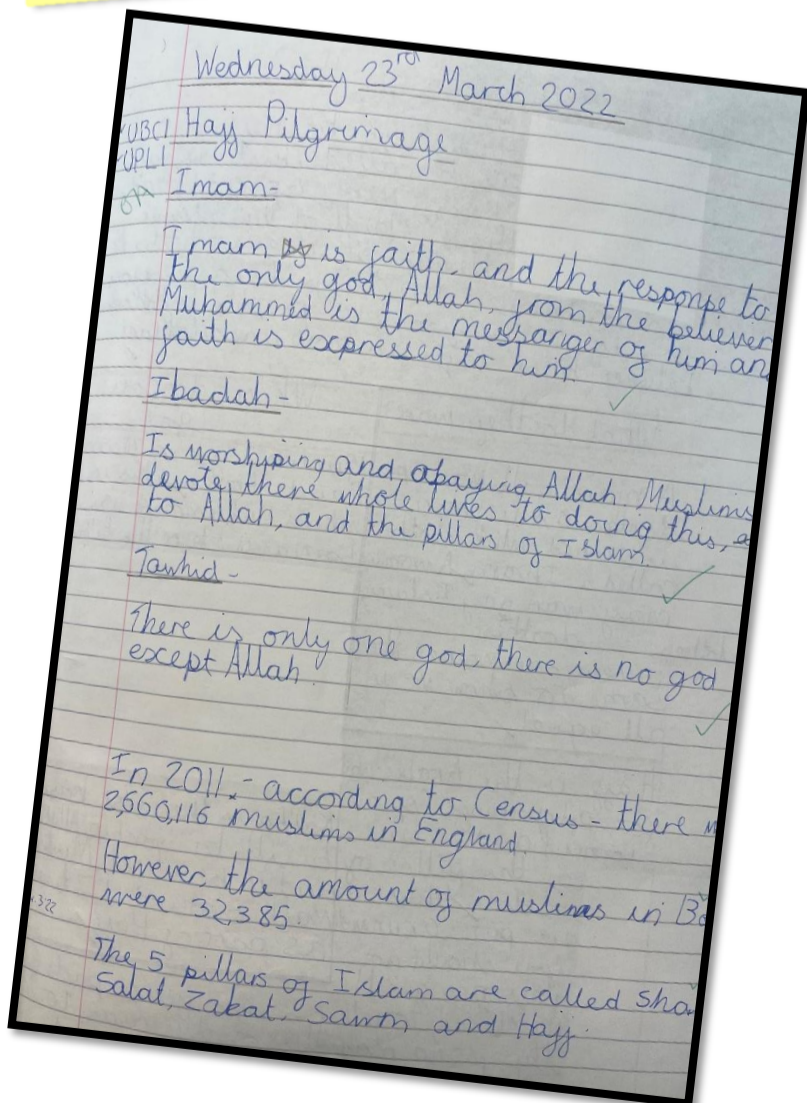
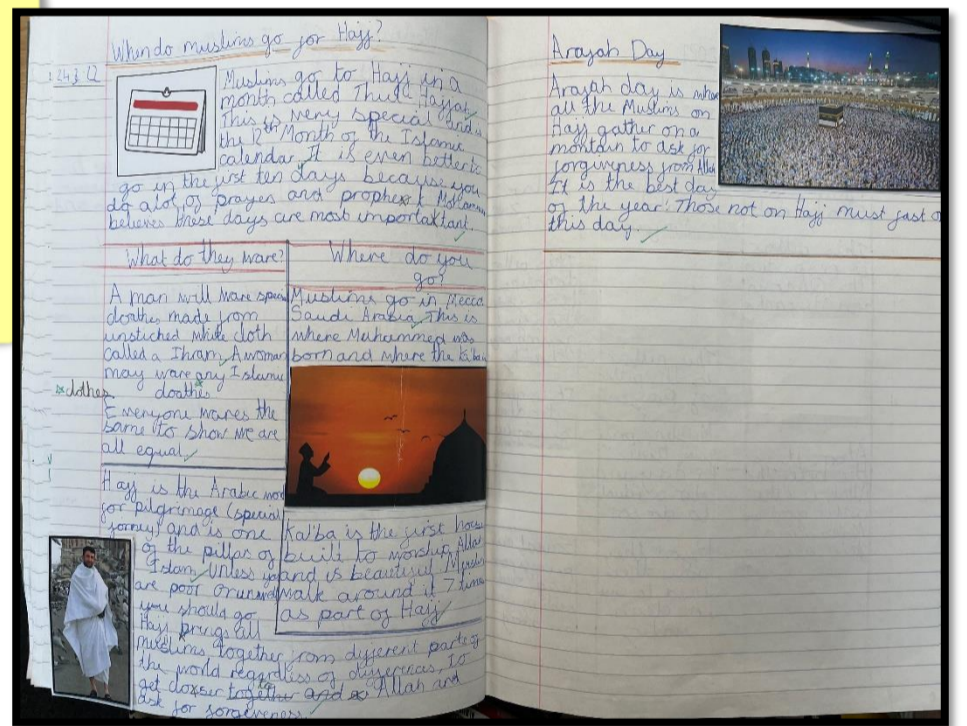
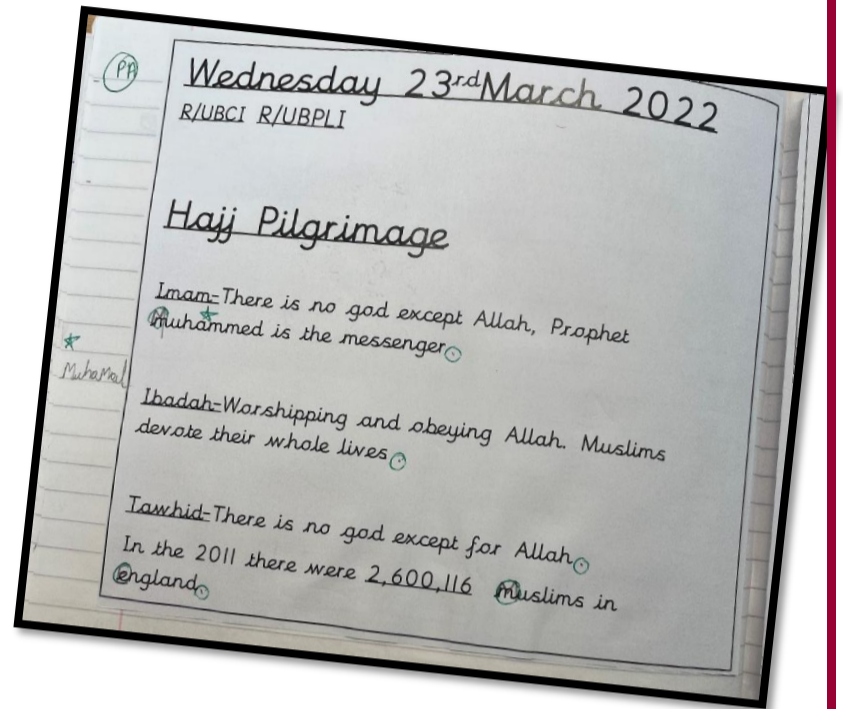
Project Reflection – Spring 2

RE – Islam

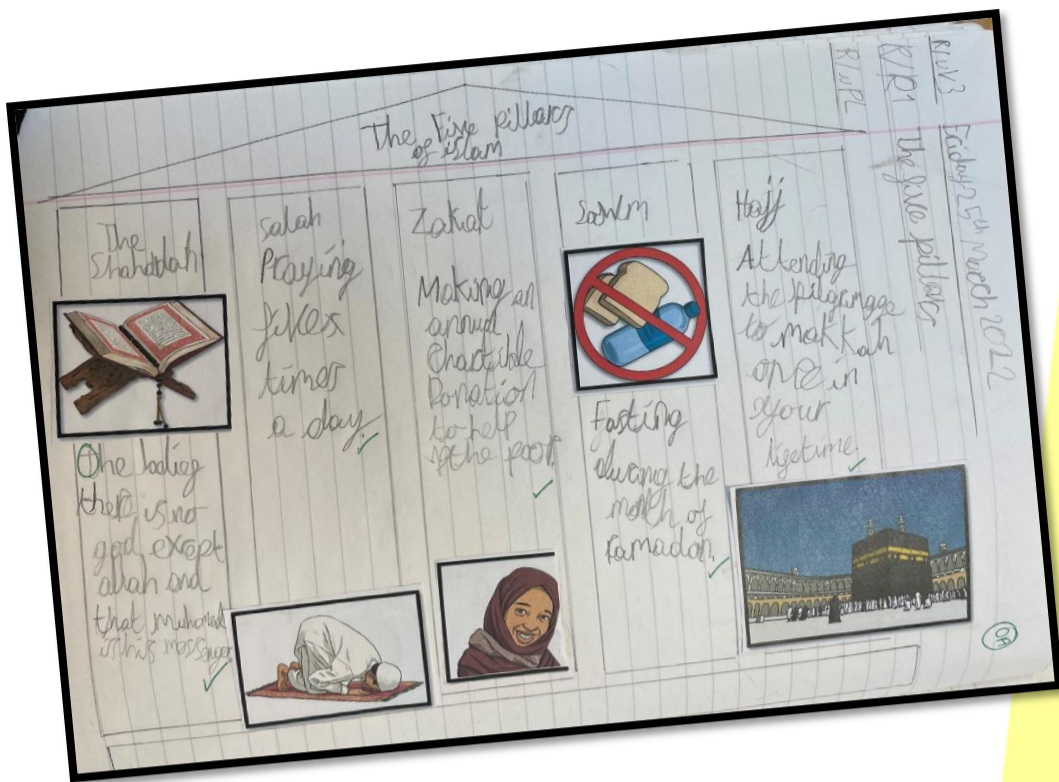
Hajj Pilgrimage

We then started to research all about it. We looked at the meaning behind Hajj, where Muslims go, when they go, Arafah, what Muslims wear and the importance.



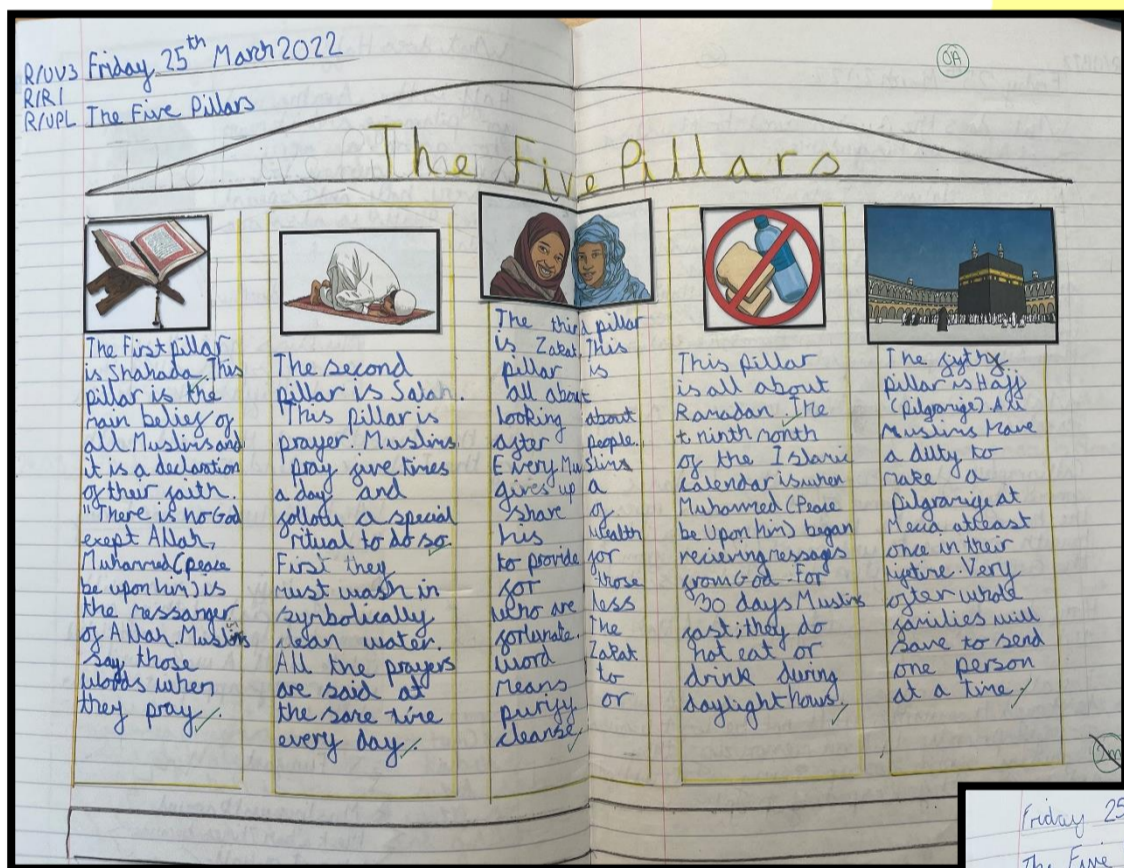

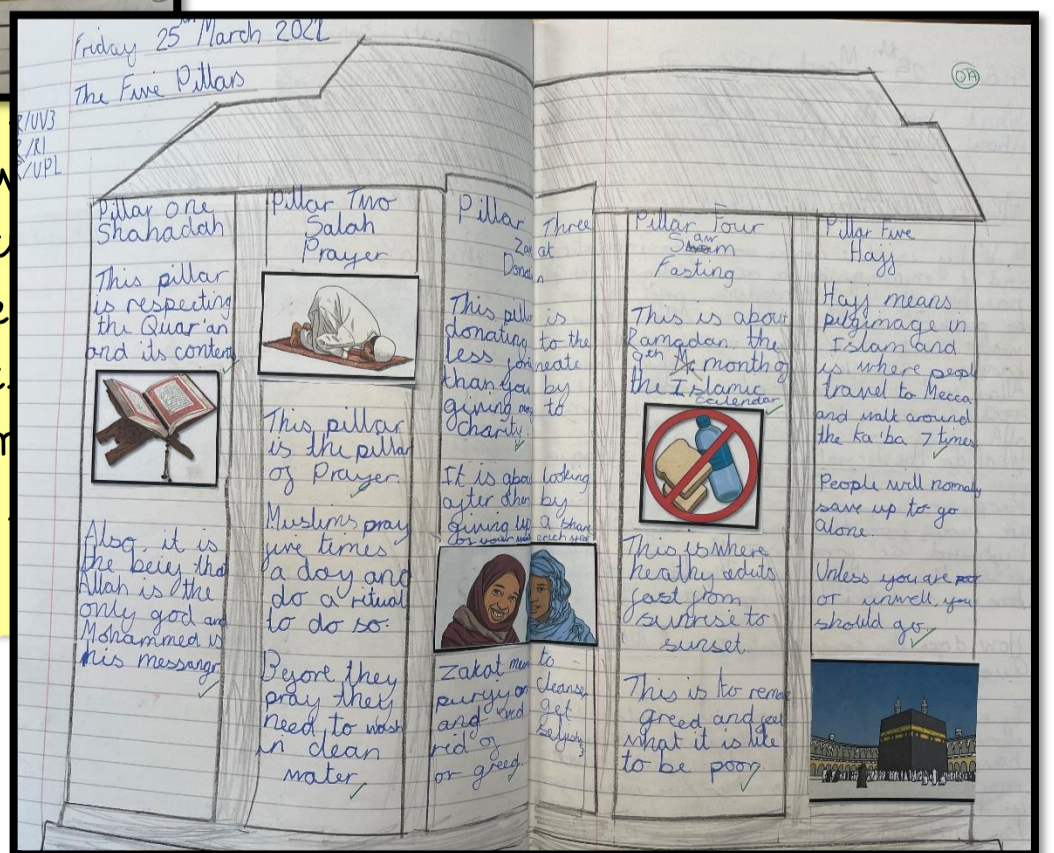
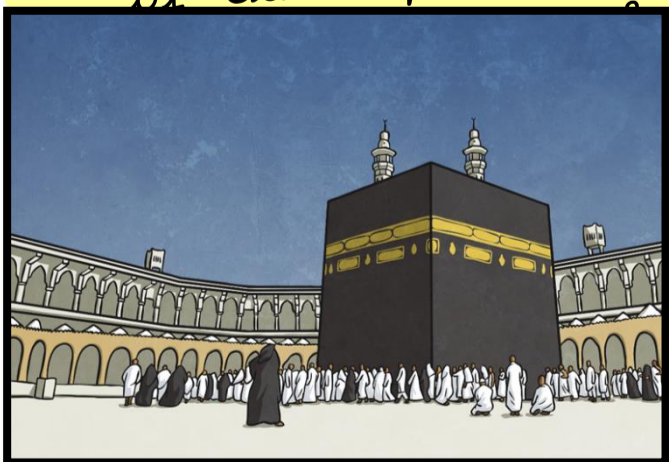
The Five Pillars

We understand that the Five Pillars as expressions of Ibadah (worship and belief in action).



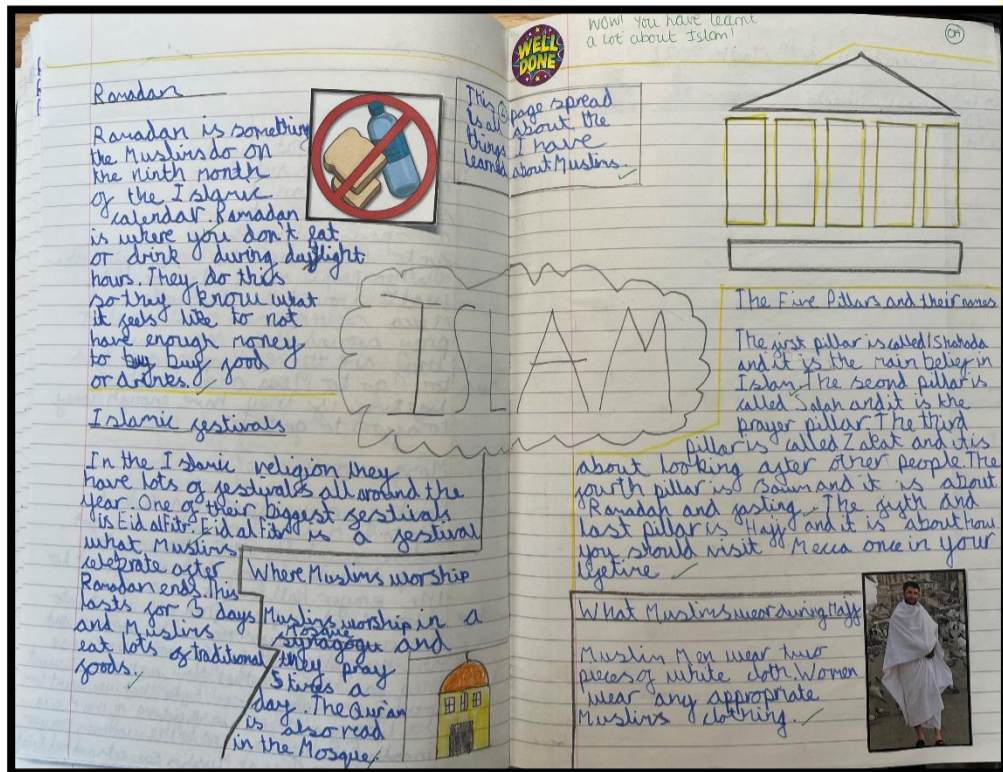

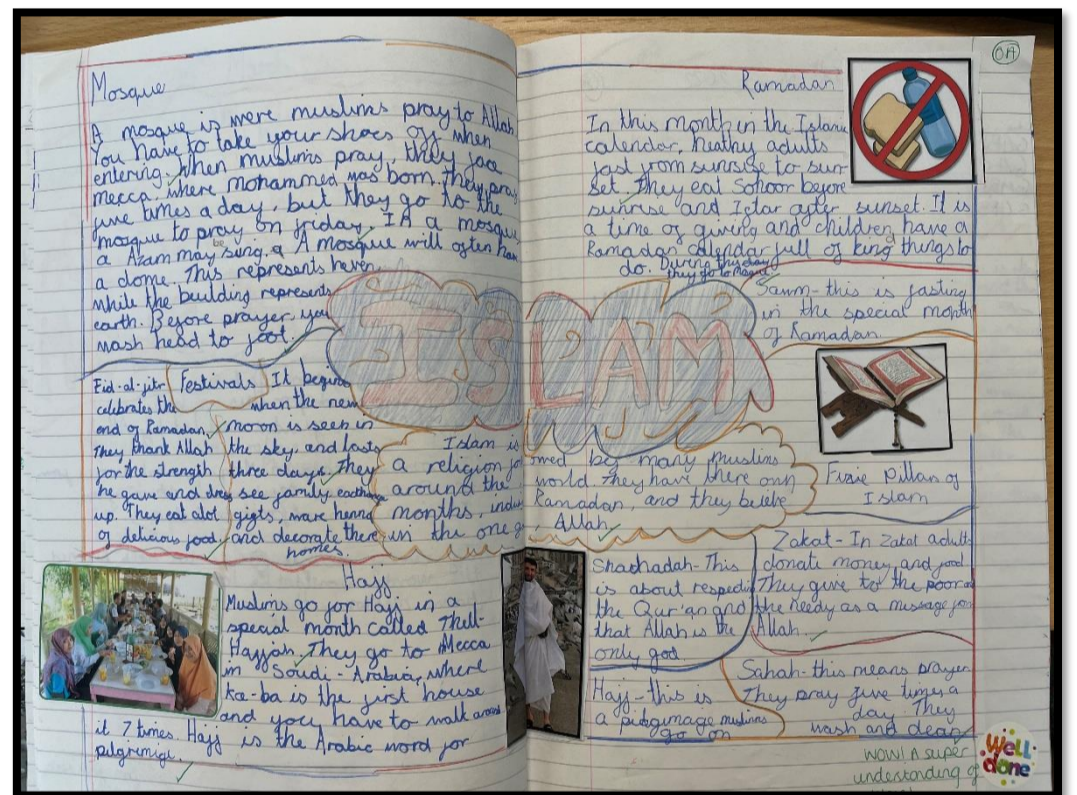

Hajj Pilgrimage

Muslims go for hajj in a very special month called thul-hajjah it is the 12th month of the Islamic calendar. To make the most of it they try to make and do more good deeds. They fast and recite most of the Qur'an whilst give to charity.
