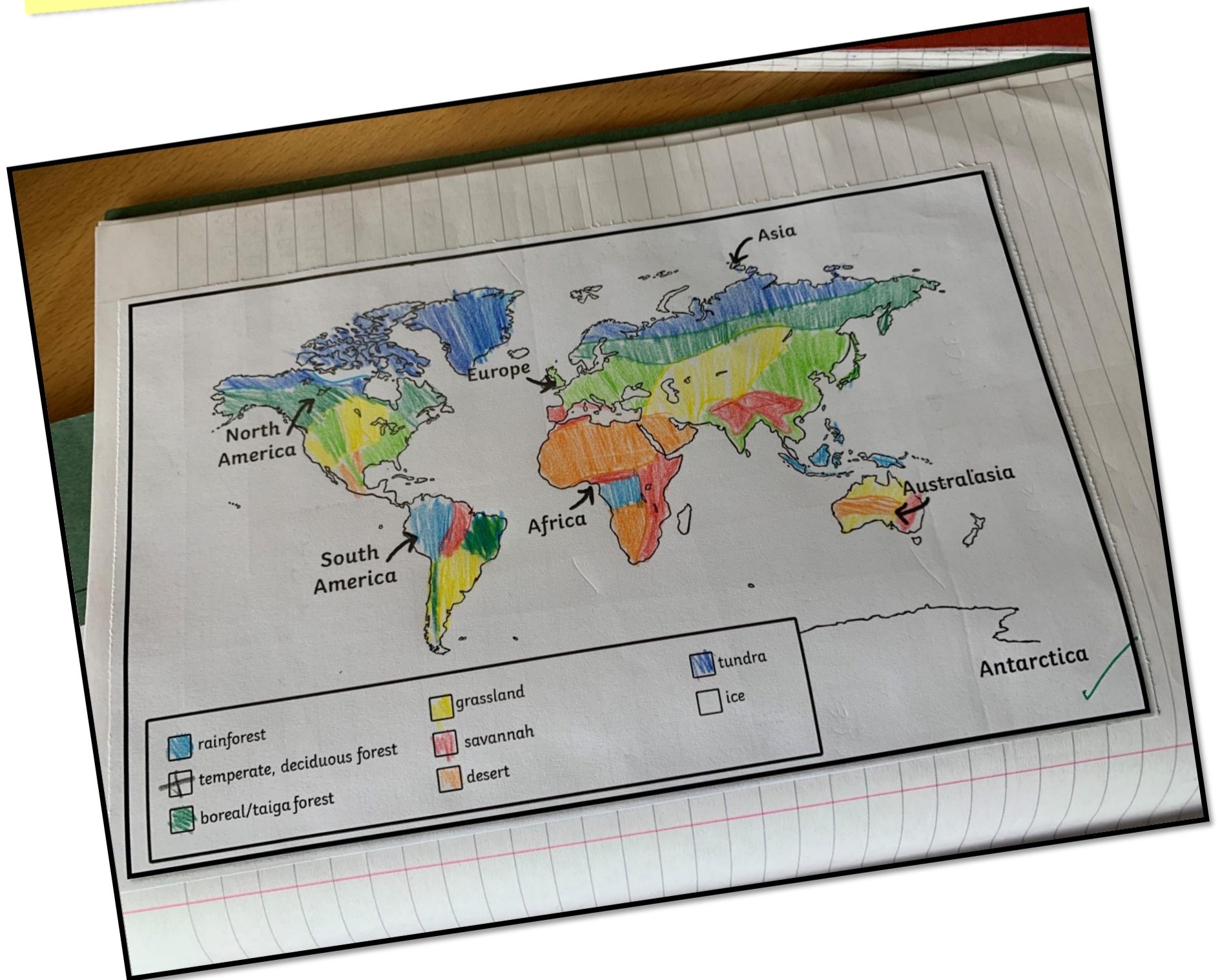
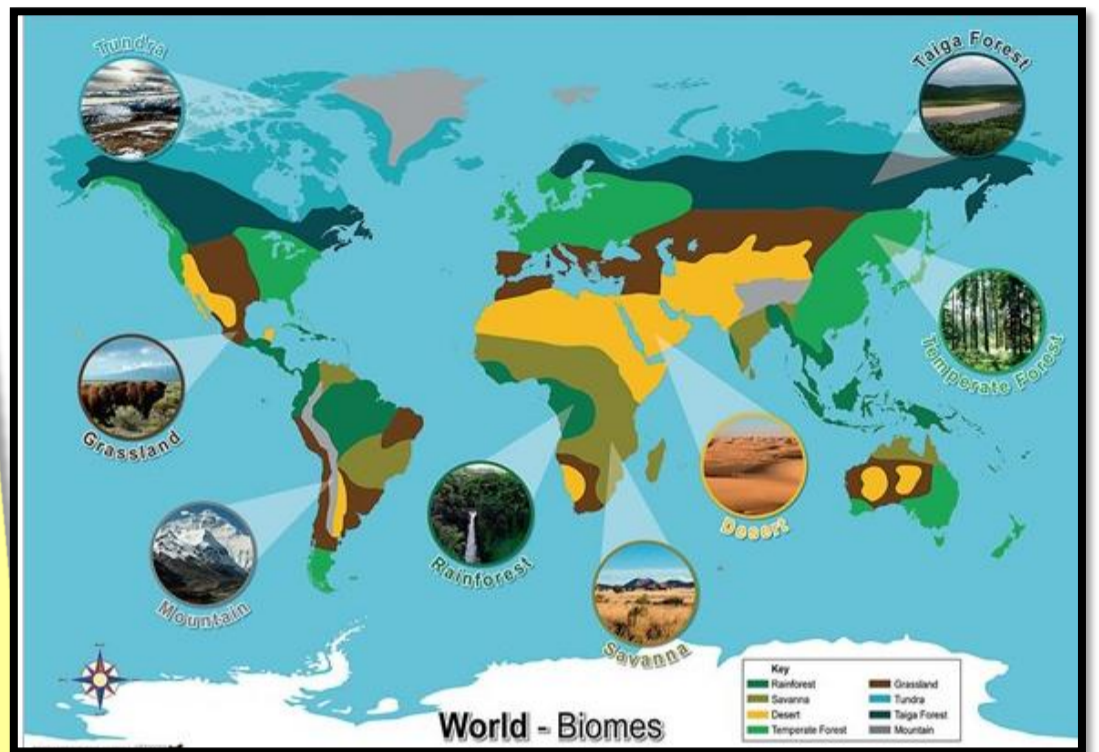
Project Reflection

desert - hot, arid areas with little vegetation
