What you need...

- Uniform
 - **Charcoal** grey jogging bottoms
 - Pale marl grey polo shirt
 - Dark Velcro Trainers (no shoe laces)
Children wear trainers all of time alongside their tracksuit bottoms
 - Burgundy jumper/ cardigan
- Transparent/clear water bottle with drinking spout (*children to bring **water** only to school*)
- Book Bag - PTFA provide this for all new starters.
- PE bag (this will stay in school)
- PE Kit (you do not need pumps as children will be wearing their trainers)
- PE kit can be ordered from Touchline
- Wellies that stay in school - no fur lined as these take longer to dry
- Waterproofs to wear on forest school days – you will be informed of your forest school day in September
- Names in EVERYTHING please!
- All orders for uniform to be completed online from Touchline or parents can source a replica from other stores if you wish. Orders can be collected from School in July. The last date for ordering is 30th June, this will ensure your order is delivered to School. If you prefer, you can pay an additional cost to have a home delivery.

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

Universal Infant Free School Meals
